### **Worship**

Welcome to Plymouth Heights CRC. Our hope is that you discover a sense of belonging, and that you have a thoughtful and joyful encounter with God's abundant grace offered in Christ as we celebrate Communion.

During the 2023-2024 ministry year, we are studying "Faith Practices". Our current practice is "Celebration". Our memory verse for this practice is Psalm 145:7: "[We] celebrate your abundant goodness and joyfully sing of your righteousness."

**Banners**: During this season of Easter we celebrate the victory of Jesus and his Kingship over the whole universe. The white and gold colors in these banners represent the joy of Christ's victory over sin and death. The gold cords symbolize the royal character of Christ's shed blood. Isaiah 53: 5 reminds us that "by his stripes we are healed." The wedge-shaped panels in two of the banners represent the torn veil, the sign that we have full access to God's presence through Christ. The season of Easter is celebrated for seven Sundays, the number portrayed by the three white and two gold panels, plus the two groups of gold cords in each banner.
