Plymouth Heights Christian Reformed Church Weather Cancellation Policy

The decision to cancel worship services and church activities/events will be made by a Weather Cancellation Committee (consisting of four members of the Administrative Committee) after very careful consideration.

The cancellation of worship services and church activities/events will be communicated via:

- Mass email
- Group text
- Church voicemail greeting
- Church website homepage (www.phcrc.org)
- WOOD-TV Channel 8 (and WOTV Channel 41), WXMI Fox Channel 17, WZZM TV Channel

Ordinarily, the cancellation of worship services and church activities/events will be communicated to the congregation *no later than 7:00 a.m. Sunday morning* or 4:00 p.m. on midweek evenings.

Winter Weather

If a Winter Storm Warning has been issued well in advance, and inclement winter weather has already commenced by Saturday evening, a cancellation decision *may* be made by 10:00 p.m. Saturday evening.

Ordinarily, worship services and church activities/events may be canceled if:

- The Weather Cancellation Committee determines that inclement winter weather represents a significant hazard to the safety of a majority of church members.
- A Winter Storm Warning has been issued for the time (approximately 24-hour period) surrounding a worship service.

If Sunday morning worship has been canceled due to inclement winter weather, **all** Sunday activities will be automatically canceled that day.

Mid-week activities and events will be automatically canceled if school has been canceled due to inclement weather.

Summer/Tornado Weather

If a tornado watch is in effect one hour before the beginning of a worship service or a scheduled meeting in the church building, that service or meeting is automatically canceled. If a tornado watch is announced during a worship service or meeting, that service or meeting will be terminated.
